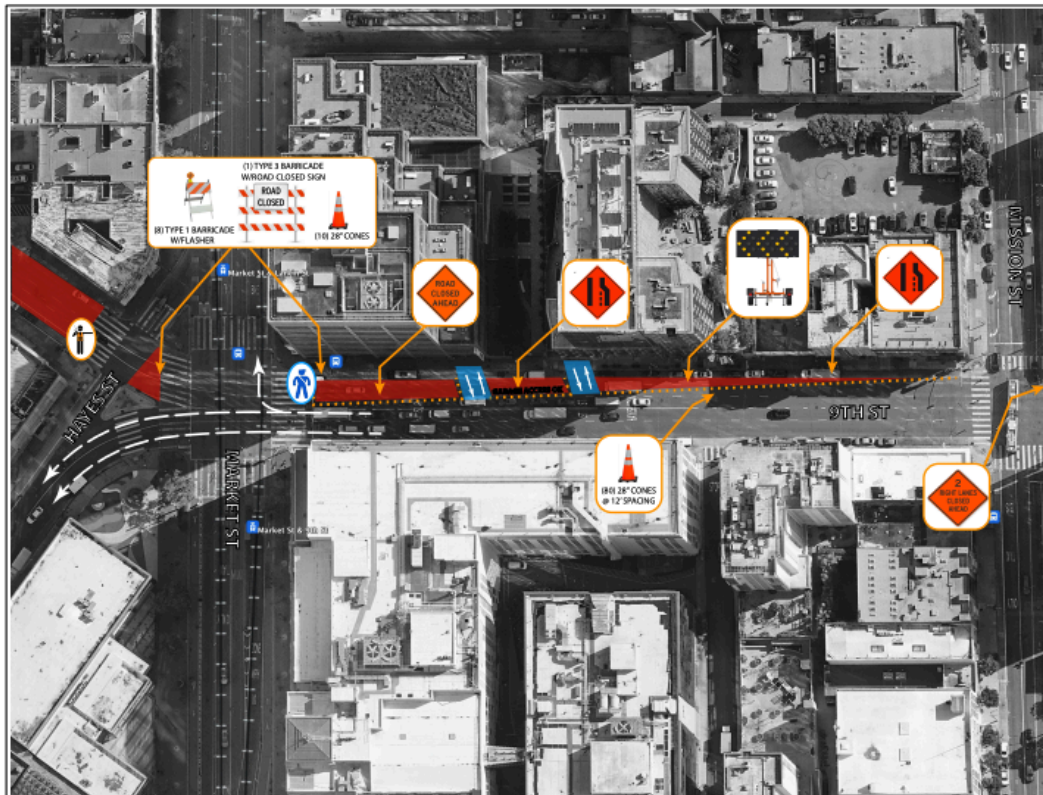

Open Gate Systems will be utilized at all entrances to the Celebration Site

Allied Universal (formally Unified Command) will be installing eighteen (18) HD PTZ Cameras throughout the Celebration Site

SF Pride Celebration Command will be located on the 3rd Floor of BGCA (Grove Hallway)

SF PRIDE CELEBRATION AT CIVIC CENTER PLAZA BAG POLICY AND LIST OF PROHIBITED ITEMS

Security will allow bags that are: Totally clear plastic vinyl or PV and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12. (Search for "clear stadium approved bags" but double check measurements!)

- Small clutch bags, which cannot exceed 4.5" x 6.5" in size with or without a handle.

Using festival and event best practices, travel light, stay hydrated, and enjoy the day.

The following items are not permitted:

Weapons, regardless of permit

Umbrellas

Cans, thermoses and glass bottles

Any water bottle sealed or not. Empty plastic water bottles allowed.

Outside beverages and beverage containers

Outside food products and containers

Chairs of any kind

Alcoholic beverages

Beach balls and inflatables

Baseball bats

Banners, Totems or Oversized Signage

Marketing/promotional material for solicitation

Use of laser pointers

Noisemakers, musical instruments, whistles, air horns and boom boxes

Drones or Remote-Control Aircraft, Toys/Cars of any kind or size prohibited

Pets (Except for service animals)

Wrapped packages

Professional photographic tools or equipment (tripods, monopods and lenses longer than 6 inches) unless accompanied by an official Media Credential

Waste Management and Clean Up

Recycling:

San Francisco Pride provides marked disposal cans for recycling, composting, and trash. Marked signs will also be posted. All beverage cups used at our event are 100% recyclable. Additionally, SF Pride has required for several years running that our food exhibitors use and distribute 100% compostable plates, cups, and other materials.

Recycling Plan

We will have recycling locations on site as a part of compounds.

Main Compound: Larkin Street between Hayes and Grove (Wells Fargo Parking Lot)

- 4 x 30 yard trash dumpsters
- 6 x 20 yard recycle dumpsters
- 3 x 14 yard compostable
- 1 x 20 yard mixed debris

We will also have Recycling “mini” stations throughout the site in locations that will not impede the flow of traffic. All Beverage Booths will have 3 stream stations. Diversion reports will be generated by Recology post event.

Event Cleanup Plan

1. DPW: Wells Fargo Parking lot on Grove near Larkin cleaned and deodorized Friday 7 PM.
2. DPW: Post festival cleanup Sunday 9:00 PM. Although the event ends at 6:30PM we will need time to allow the exhibitors and attendees a chance to leave the area.
3. DPW: Steam clean sidewalks where necessary.
4. DPW: Special attention to the street sweeping along the streets of Turk, Polk, Golden Gate and Larkin around the Federal Building.
5. SFP: We will include in the exhibitor packet information, about how each exhibitor must leave their area, defined as their 10" x 10" space, plus 10" in front, in back and to the side if they are a corner space, in broom



clean condition. We will provide them with two trash bags each, more if they request them. The bagged trash will be left on the sidewalk behind their space.

6. SFP: We will maintain the area around Civic Center Plaza during the event with a staff of six on Saturday and twenty on Sunday.

7. SFP: We will do a cleanup on Sunday morning.

8. DPW: Parade Route Cleanup Sunday after the Parade, starting approximately at 2PM.

9. SF Pride provides extra help for DPW with the post event cleanup at Civic Center Plaza, specifically to sweep the accumulated trash into the center of each street for DPW mechanized pickup as well as cleaning Civic Center Plaza.

10. SFP: We will have a team do a final cleanup of Civic Center Plaza on Monday morning after a walkthrough with Rec and Park at 9AM.

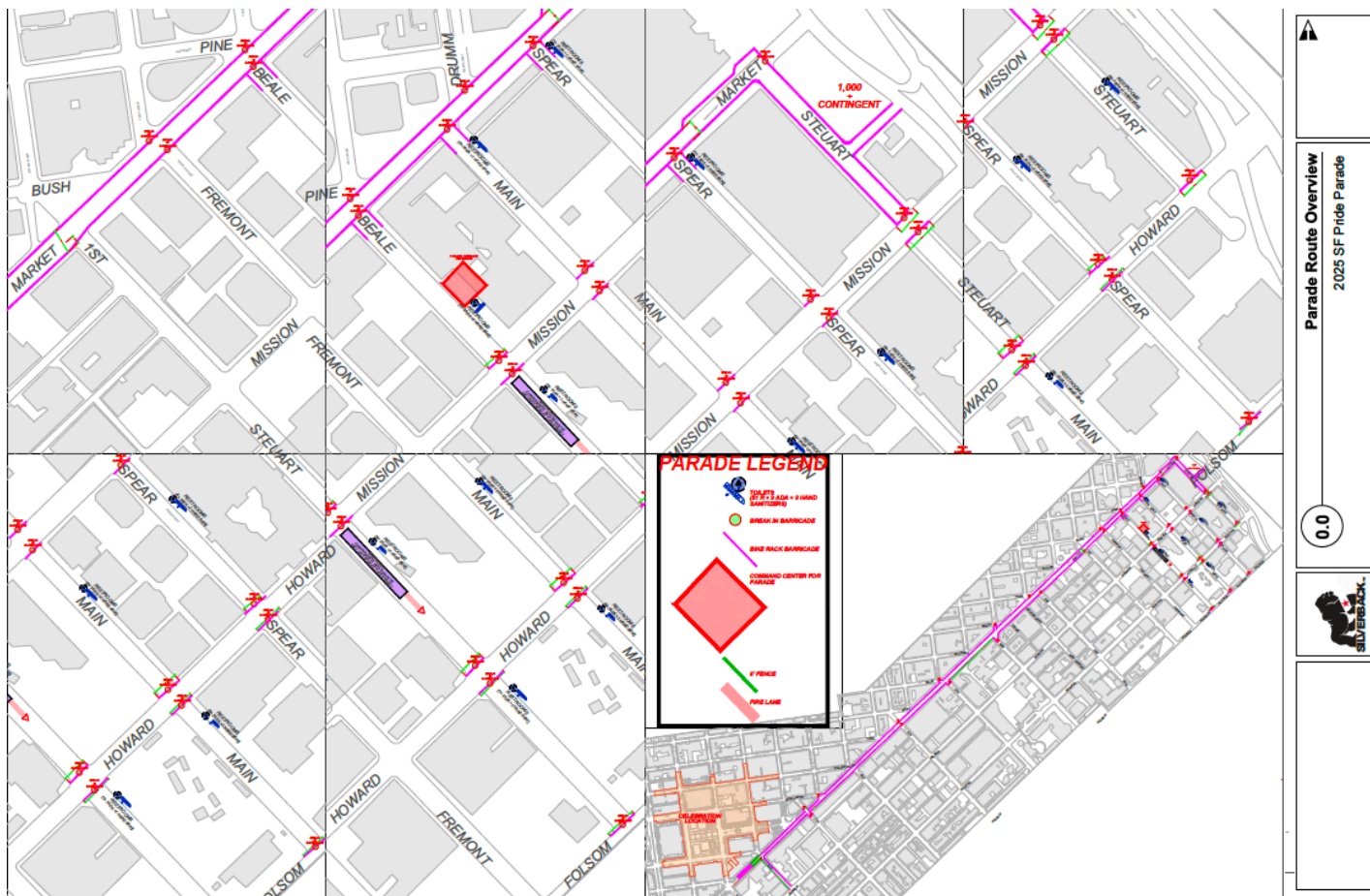


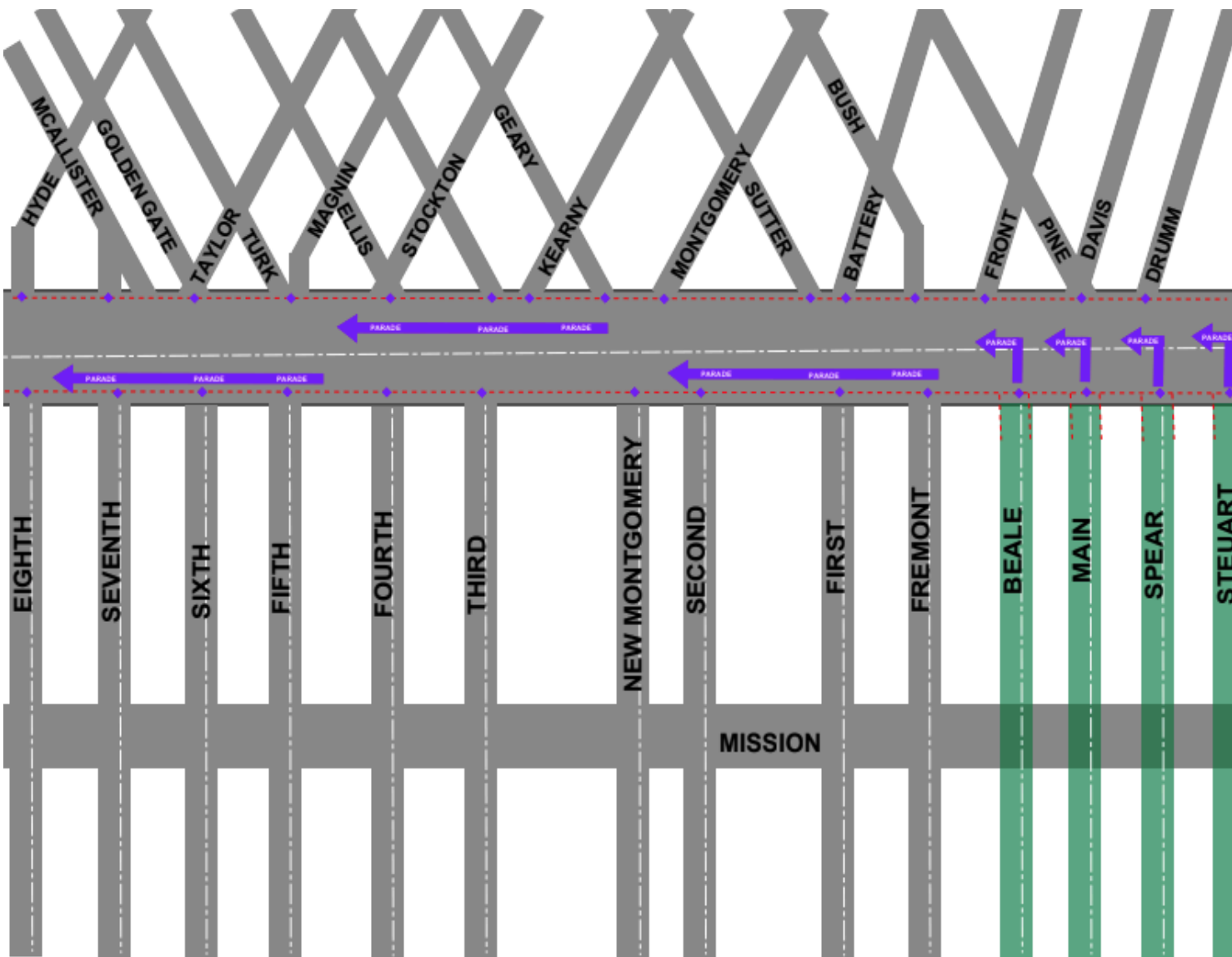

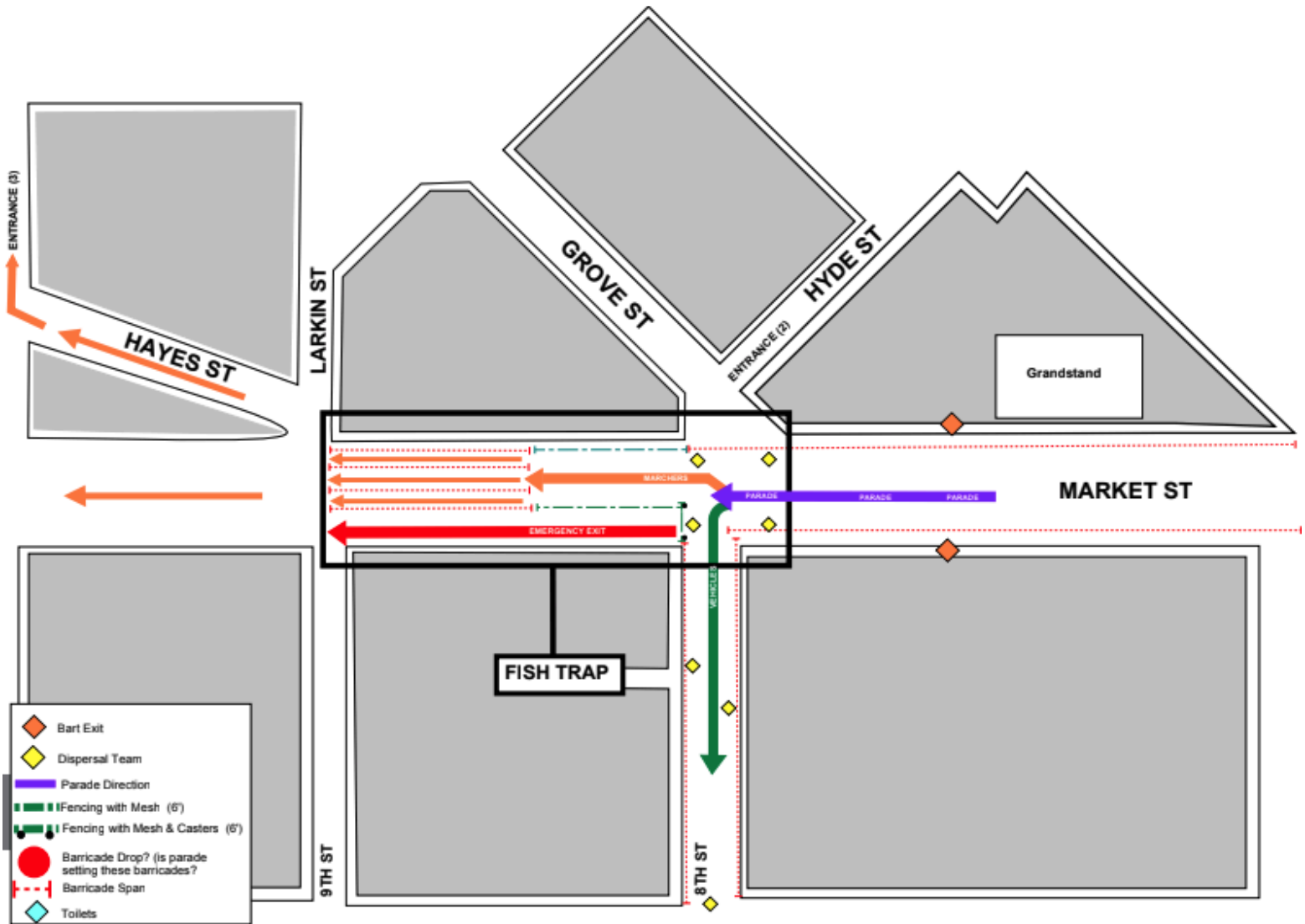
